Chaos Glassworks Studio – art gallery & workshop. 121A Hanford St. (Old Hwy 49), Sutter Creek.

Miners Bend Park with self-guided tours of historic mining equipment.

Volcano - Black Chasm Caverns – National Natural Landmark; 15701 Pioneer-Volcano Rd, Volcano, CA 95689. There is a 45 minute guided Walk Tour, 3 hr. Above ground Labyrinth Tour, Nature Hike Gemstone Mining. Gold Panning and shopping.

Lone – Preston Castle 209-256-3623. By 1894 the iconic Preston Castle began as a reformatory for youth housing inmates from San Quentin and Alcatraz, Self-guided tours \$15.00 from 10:00AM to 1:00PM. Guided Tours \$20.00 for 60 minutes at 1:00PM, 1:30PM & 2:00PM. Refer to the Amador Country magazine.

Clark’s Corner to see Amador County’s cattle brands on the back wall.

Amador City – Andrea’s Bakery & Cheese Shop a European-style bakery. Specialties in bread, pastries & desserts.

Amador Olive Oil Company

Town provides a self-guided walking tour.

Dine on the patio of the Imperial Hotel; stroll to find locally – made products & friendly shopkeepers.

Pine Grove – Chaw-se Indian Grinding Rock - State Historical Park, 8 miles east of Jackson. Mortar holes for grinding acorns and other seeds, petroglyphs 2,000 to 3,000 years old . Museum is free and open from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Refer to the Amador County magazine.
